CLASSROOM NEWS

Math: We have started Topic 2 which covers adding and subtracting larger numbers, along with estimation and determining whether an equation is reasonable.

Reading: This Friday, we will have a small assessment to see how well they understand how setting and events have an effect on characters and their actions. We will be looking at cause and effect, character traits, and visualizing this week prior to the assessment.

Writing: Our current writing is all about comparing and contrasting characters from Flying Solo and using text evidence in our essays. We will focus a lot more on structure this week, such as paragraphs, indentation, topic and closing sentences. Don't be surprised or worried about your child receiving a lower score on their first writing assignment. They will be given much more instruction and guidance on future pieces and will see a lot of growth.

Science: We are starting a new project this week. Students have been introduced to biomimicry, so feel free to ask them all about it. They will be creating an invention of their own using an animal or plant adaptation. This is done in class, but they may need to bring materials from home when working on the prototype here at school.
